The month of Safar comes after Muharram, is one of the twelve Hijri months. It's name comes of the emptying (isfaar) of Makkah (i.e., its people would all leave) when they traveled during this month or because they used to raid other tribes at this time, and they would take all their belongings away and they would leave them with nothing.
