**Al-Hijrah is a great source of lessons in every place AND time;** The Islamic calendar, based purely on lunar cycles, was first introduced in 638 C.E. by the close companion of the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) and the second Caliph, `Umar ibn Al-Khattab (may Allah be pleased with him), who lived from 592 to 644 C.E. in an attempt to reconcile the various, at times conflicting, systems being used for dating during his time. However, the Hijrah calendar is not just a sentimental system of time reckoning for Muslims; rather, it has a deep religious and historical significance, and has had many scientific influences on our daily lives in the areas of psychology, physiology, and the environment. By returning to the use, or at least the recognition, of the lunar calendar we gain many benefits as Muslims. From a historical angle, all of the events and celebrations of Islamic history are recorded in the Hijrah Calendar. The start of Ramadan is determined by the sighting of the crescent-moon (hilal). The Prophet (peace and blessing be upon him) has said, "Fast at its sighting, and terminate the fast at its sighting" (Al-Bukhari and Muslim). Our use of the Gregorian calendar makes us forgetful of the spirit of these events and the lessons we can learn from them. **Learn the Seerah (join us in eerah Lesson) share it with others.**

**Virtues of fasting 'Ashoraa': "For fasting the day of 'Ashoraa', I hope that Allaah will accept it as expiation for the year that went before."**(Hadith/Muslim).

**It is encouraged to fast Sep 8th -Tasoa & Sep 9th -Aashoraa, Join us in Iiftaar at the Masjid.**
