Direction to Ei'd Prayer Place (Parker Park) from ICJ (Masjid) SalatulEi'd Place:

1. Head north on N Rogers St toward E Johnson Ave
2. Turn left onto E Johnson Ave(About 3min)
3. Turn right onto N Main St (About 59 secs)
4. Continue onto N Church St (Destination will be on the right)
5. Men entrance on the main door, Women on the side door by the playground area.

Salatul-Ei'd will be according to the CDC regulation, wearing facemasks and social distancing, with your own Sij-jadah (prayer mat) at Parker Park Community Center, 1506 N Church ST, Jonesboro, Tuesday July 20th, 7:00 AM. Women's entrance is on the side.

SUNAN AL-EID:

1. It is The Sunnh to make Takber starting from the first day of Thulhijjah, July 11th - to Thulhijjah 13th, Friday 23RD July at home or work or market, standing or sitting or lying down(men aloud and women voice to themselves). * One of the Sunnh of Takber: is saying individually Allah Akber, Allah Akber, La Eelaha Eelaa Allah, Allah Akber, Allah Akber, wa leelahee alhamd. (إلا الله، الله أكبر الله أكبر والله الحمد)
2. Take a bath (Gosol), put oil or teeb (Women do not wear perfume), and use Islamic toothpick (Sewak).
3. Bring prayer Sujudah (mat). Keep the place clean and we are not responsible about your belongings.
4. Eat after SalatulEid from your Udhiyah preferably.
5. Come to the place of SalatulEid one route and go a different route.
6. Great each other by saying to each other: عيد سعيد، عيد مبارك، عيد مبارك، تقبل الله منا ومنكم Ei'd Saeed, Ei'd Mubarak.
