#### Iqra': Learn to Read the Holy Qur'an

Program Title: Mastering Quranic Reading with Al-Qaidah An-Noraniah

**Duration:** 3 Weeks

Schedule: 4 Days/Week, 2 Hours/Day (Total: 24 Hours)

**Target Group:** Learners aged 7–15 (with basic recognition of Arabic letters)

**Delivery Mode:** In-person or online, instructor-led with audio-visual support

**Instructor:** Hussain Alharbi is a lecturer in Applied Linguistics. He has 10 years of experience teaching Arabic and Tajweed to non-native speakers in Saudi Arabia, the UK, and the US.

# **Program Objectives:**

By the end of this 3-week course, learners will:

- Accurately recognize and pronounce Arabic letters in isolation and combination
- Read Quranic script with short and long vowels, sukoon, shaddah, and tanween
- Apply basic Tajweed rules including madd, ghunnah, qalqalah, and correct waqf
- Build fluency in reading simple verses from Juz 'Amma with proper articulation

### Week 1: Foundations of Letters and Vowel Sounds

Day 1	Arabic Alphabet & Letter Combinations	Lesson 1, 2	Recognize isolated and joined Arabic letters
Day 2	Disjointed Letters + Short Vowels	Lesson 3, 4	Read Quranic disjointed letters; apply Fatha, Kasrah, Dammah
Day 3	Miniature Long Vowels	Lesson 7	Recognize and read small Alif, Ya, and Waw in the Mushaf
Day 4	Long Vowels & Soft Letters	Lesson 8	Apply elongation and softness in recitation

Homework: Practice all letters and vowels using visual flashcards and audio resources

# Week 2: Vowel-Less Letters, Tanween, and Shaddah

Day	<b>Topics Covered</b>	Lessons	<b>Learning Goals</b>
Day 5	Vowel-less Letters (Sukoon)	Lesson 10	Identify and read consonant-only sounds (Sukoon)
Day 6	Tanween (Nunation)	Lesson 5	Recognize and pronounce double vowels (an, in, un)
Day 7	Doubled Letters (Shaddah)	Lesson 12	Apply Shaddah with proper doubling of consonants
Day 8	Review and Practice	Lessons 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12	Integrate vowel, sukoon, and shaddah concepts fluently

Homework: Recite from previous lessons aloud daily; reinforce with listening practice

### Week 3: Cumulative Practice & Quranic Application

Day	<b>Topics Covered</b>	Lessons	<b>Learning Goals</b>
Day 9	Advanced Practice	Lessons 6, 9, 11, 13–16	Solidify rule applications: tanween, sukoon, shaddah with vowels
Day 10	Applying Rules in Real Quranic Text	Practice from Juz 'Amma	Read short surahs with correct rules and fluency
Day 11	Peer and Audio-Visual Tajweed Practice	Custom	Improve accuracy and rhythm using group recitation and model audio
Day 12	Final Assessment + Parent Showcase	Review	Evaluate fluency, Tajweed accuracy, and student confidence

Outcome: Learners transition confidently into full Quran recitation from Juz 'Amma
